House Rules

DRESS

Members, their children, and their guests are expected to be in appropriate attire at all times. It is the responsibility of the members to see that their guests are so informed.

In the member dining rooms; gentlemen and male children are to wear golf attire at all times, at a minimum. Golf shirts must be tucked in, resort style casual wear does not (i.e. Tommy Bahama). Tee shirts and slogan tee shirts are not acceptable in the dining areas. Sweat suits, sweatshirts, sweat shorts or sports team jerseys are not acceptable attire for these areas. Clean denim is acceptable (no holes or rips).

Gentlemen and male children are not permitted to wear hats when seated in the member dining room or bar/lounge area at any time. Hats are permitted on the patio, in the Golf Shop, locker room and card room. Hats are not permitted to be worn backwards anywhere on the property.

Member functions each have a published dress code. The appropriate dress code for each social event will be listed in the announcement of the particular event.

CHILDREN

Members are responsible for the behavior of their children. Parents are reminded that their children are held to the same standards of respect, decorum and dress code as the members.

CHILDREN AGES 0-12 YEARS

We kindly request the cooperation of all parents in maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment in our dining areas and outdoor spaces. Ensuring the safety of children and the satisfaction of all diners is of utmost importance to us.

- Inside our dining rooms, we ask parents to please keep their children seated at the table to prevent any accidents or disruptions to other diners' experiences.
- Outside on our patio, we appreciate your support in ensuring that children refrain from running on the walls or around the patio area. We kindly request parents to maintain clear oversight of their children and direct their energy to appropriate areas. Furthermore, for safety and protection, we ask parents to keep their children within sight at all times when outdoors. When golfers are on the tee, we urge parents to prevent their children from being near the tee areas to avoid any potential hazards. We must emphasize that children should not engage in any play activities on the practice putting green under any circumstances. These are highly sensitive areas.

Your cooperation in adhering to these guidelines is greatly appreciated, as it contributes to a safer and more enjoyable experience for everyone. Thank you for your understanding and support.

CHILDREN AGES 13-18 YEARS

Junior members are expected to adhere to all adult rules to ensure a harmonious and respectful environment for all members, regardless of age.

No one under the age of 18 is allowed in the card rooms or in the bar/lounge (excludes dining room) area after 9:00 p.m. except to pass through from dining room to main exit. No one under the age of 21 is permitted to sit at the bar at any time.

CELL PHONE POLICY

Cell phone usage for incoming or outgoing call conversation is not permitted in the indoor member dining rooms to include the bar/lounge and the ballroom dining areas. This includes no ringing phones or music tones. Please put your phone on silent or vibrate before entering these areas. Phone texting, PDA emailing, and laptop use are permitted.

ALCOHOL

While on the club premises no alcoholic beverages may be consumed which are not purchased from the club. This is a New Hampshire law. No alcoholic beverage may be served at any time to anyone under the age of 21, either by club staff or by a parent. Management has the right and the responsibility to refuse to serve an alcoholic beverage at any time for an appropriate reason. Any violations will be referred immediately to the Board of Directors.

SMOKING

Manchester Country Club is a smoke-free facility. Smoking is prohibited inside structures and dining areas, including the Patio.

PETS

No pets are permitted anywhere on the premises of Manchester Country Club.

LOCKER ROOM

Use of our locker rooms is restricted to members and escorted guests. White towels are for showering and should not be removed from the locker areas. Utility towels are provided for use on the golf course.

EMPLOYEES

Just as we expect our employees to treat us with respect, so are members, their children, and their guests expected to treat our employees with respect. No one is to reprimand an employee. Supervision of our employees is the responsibility of management. If an issue arises, the member is to bring the issue to the attention of one of our managers.
